## Freelance hardware selector



The TB806 ModuleBus Cable Adaptor is used together with TB805 and TK801V0xx to extend the ModuleBus. Using this extension I/O modules on the same electrical ModuleBus can be mounted on different DIN rails. TB806 can also be used together with TB842 to provide an optical extension of the ModuleBus.
